POPs are regulated worldwide by the Stockholm Convention and implemented in the European Union by the "Persistent Organic Pollutants (POPs)" Regulation published on 20 June 2019 (EU/2019/1021). The regulation restricts the use of persistent organic pollutants in both chemical products and articles.
