Challenge Electronics hereby certifies, to the best of our knowledge, parts supplied by Challenge Electronics do not include the materials noted within the January 6, 2021, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) for final rules under the Toxic Substances Control Act (TSCA) Section 6(h) to restrict the importation and use of five persistent, bioaccumulative, and toxic (PBT) chemicals.

These chemicals include:

- PIP (3:1) (phenol, isopropylated phosphate (3:1), CAS 68937-41-7), a phosphate flame retardant and plasticizer
- DecaBDE (decabromodiphenyl ether, CAS 1163-19-5), a brominated flame retardant
- 2,4,6 TTBP (2,4,6-tris(tert-butyl)phenol, CAS 732-26-3), an antioxidant, lubricant, and fuel additive
- HCBT (hexachlorobutadiene, CAS 87-68-3), a chlorinated hydraulic, heat transfer, or transformer fluid
- PCTP (pentachlorothiophenol, CAS 133-49-3), a chlorinated plasticizer
